Dedicating a child at SRC acknowledges God's sovereignty not only over the child, but also we as parents. Parents present their child before God and the church, thanking Him for the precious gift of life, and asking for grace and wisdom in carrying out their responsibilities.

Deuteronomy 6:4-7 - "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. 6 And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

This passage instructs first parents, and then the church in the importance of Scriptures, not only in the life of the parents, but the life of their children as well. At SRC we firmly believe the bulk of what a child learns about the Lord is first, and best taught in the home amongst family. Next, we believe it is our privilege and duty to come alongside parents and families, being diligent to consistently and faithfully point to the Gospel, and God's provision for this life and the life to come through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Child dedication at SRC is an affirmation of the privilege God gives us as His people to partner together in this endeavor, encouraging one another to look to and trust in Christ alone to save, sanctify, and sustain our children as only He is able to do.
